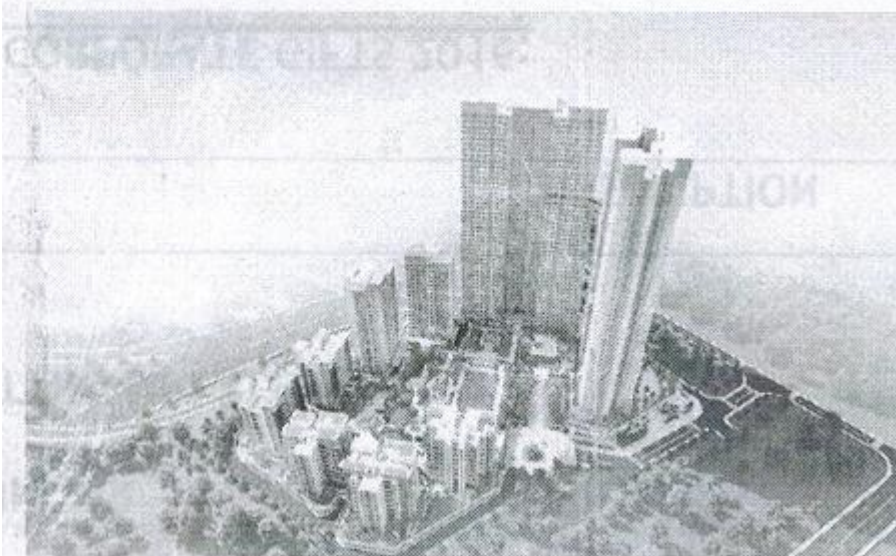
The company also has extensive presence in hospitality, property investment and management
